The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter read above has sent proposal for Constitution of the Tamil Nadu Biodiversity Board under Section 22 of the Biological Diversity Act 2002 (Central Act 18 of 2003).

2. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and in consultation with National Biodiversity Board, establish the Tamil Nadu Biodiversity Board under section 22 (1) of the said Act as appended in the Notification to this Order and this will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

3. The functions of the Board have been provided under Section 23 of the said Act. The term of Office for Non Official Members is three years.
